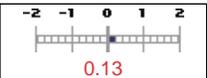
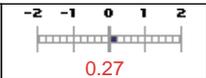

This course was one of my top 2 CS courses at UVA.

Professor Weimer is an enthusiastic lecture and passionate teacher which combine to make this a great class. It was hard but thats what we knew we were getting our selves into.

I don't know what you should do, but this class had ruined my life. I have spent more time on this class than the rest of my classes combined this semester. However, knowing what I know now I would take this class again! Can you make this a four or five credit course...?

The course is very intense and demanding in terms of pace and time commitment outside of class but Prof. Weimer effectively conveys the subject matter and provides ample extra assistance to get through the class.

This course is one of the best offered in the Computer Science Department and professor Weimer us certainly the best professor I have had in Computer Science.

This was a great course. A ridiculous amount of work but that was known information from the first day of the course. The instructor was enthusiastic and taught very well.

Probably the most worthwhile course in the CS department. This is one of the best courses I have taken. Rarely do you get a course with 1) Good lectures 2) Good organization/fair grading and 3) an appropriate workload. In most classes I have taken, you are lucky if you get 2/3, and most don't even make one. This class raises the bar. Not only were the lectures entertaining, but we learned a great deal. The work was challenging but not time consuming. The class was THE most organized class I have been in. Grading was fair and transparent, resources were provided and easily accessed, and the professor effectively adapted to feedback. Probably the best course in the CS department.
